

Supplemental Information About Copyright and Images

All contributors are responsible for determining if their work reproduces material that requires permission (e.g., photographs, artwork, quotations). While the journal and the press will assist contributors throughout this process, all contributors are responsible for paying permission fees. It is imperative that contributors identify all items as early as possible (preferably upon submission) in order to avoid delaying the journal's publishing schedule.

If submitting an article with images, note that images must not be supplementary and should be essential to the argument of the article. All images must be at least four inches wide at 300 dpi. If they are photographs or scans, only submit TIF or JPG files. If using graphs or line art, submit vector files such as PDF, AI, EPS, or SVG. It is strongly recommended that authors include all images in high quality format with captions at the time of submission. Submit the article with the abstract and keywords as one file in Word format (DOC or DOCX). Please attach the image files alongside the article file. Use captions in the article file to indicate the precise placement of each image.
